#### MAFCA National Tour – American Civil War June 15-22

We traveled 6 days to the national Model A Ford Club of America (MAFCA) meet in Waynesboro VA to participate in tour of Civil War battlefields and historic sites over a 900-mile loop in our Model As. After a stopover in Phoenix to visit family, we proceeded through Northern AZ on our way to Gallup New Mexico (passed by the Petrified Forest). From there we made our way across the country on I-40 stopping in Shamrock Texas staying on Route 66; had dinner at Rusty's (an original historical building with great food and that famous Texas charm) and walked after around to see historic sites. From there we drove to Russellville AR and stopped for the night. Proceeding east we crossed into Tennessee after crossing the Mississippi river near Memphis. We stopped in Monterey TN and had dinner at Los Agaves; great food reasonably priced. Our last day we traveled 425 miles from Monterey to Waynesboro arrive Saturday 14 June as planned. On Sunday 15 June we got the car out of the trailer and got her (Abigail) cleaned up and ready to go. Then we went and picked up our registration package.






